ACTION PLAN INITIATIVES AND HART

How can you use our tools to develop and justify action plans



- Promoting and allowing more housing types that serve vulnerable populations
- Promoting regulated multi-tenanted housing forms (e.g. boarding houses or SRO)
- Implementing land use changes mandating a min # of family units (units with 2+ bedrooms) or allowing for office conversions to residential with min family unit requirements



- Enable mixed-use redevelopment of city-owned properties, while maintaining the current government use, e.g. building housing on top of a library or office space
- Create a process for the disposal of city-owned land assets to non-profits for the development of affordable housing as-of-right (not requiring rezoning)



 Partnering with non-profit housing providers to preserve and increase the stock of affordable housing
